Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections for Bal Vatika is restricted to 03 (01 each for Bal Vatika I,II & III respectively). Further, the total number of sections for classes 1st to 10th shall be restricted to 12 only. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of 500 sq ft and greater in dimension.
2	The school is not maintaining the Mandatory Public Disclosure link with public documents uploaded thereon at its website for access to the public. The given link on school website is not functional and showing the public documents . As per Board guidelines and circular no 09/2021 the school should have a functional website with all mandatory documents available on the Mandatory public disclosure link for easy access to the public on school website in compliance of Circular No : 09/2021 Date of (21 May 2021) - Display of "Mandatory Public Disclosure" at Home Page in school's website under prominent icon leveled as "Mandatory Public Disclosure"). School is directed to make the website functional with all documents uploaded on the MPD link directly accessible to all from school website and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
3	School is not covered by safe concrete boundary wall of appropriate height from all sides. School has created temporary wall by erecting iron sheets at some places which is a temporary arrangement posing safety concern to the students and the staff. School should be covered with proper concrete boundary wall of appropriate height (preferably 06 ft) from all sides with all recommended safety measures. School is directed to raise the height of boundary wall from all sides and upload the compliance on SARAS portal with video link within 03 months.
4	The composite science lab has plastic stools for seating arrangements and no fire extinguishers seen available. Plastic items are not safe due to heating facilities and concentrate chemicals. The school is directed to upgrade the lab with all recommended infrastructure and safety measures and mandated by Board guidelines vide circular no 11/2022 and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.
5	The CwSN toilets arranged by the school are with narrow entrance and have less space inside for navigation and movement of the wheelchair/walker. School should re-arrange the CwSN toilets to make the same accessible by wheelchair bound person with ramp at entrance in compliance of the RPwD Act and the Board guidelines vide circular no 05/2023. School should arrange the CwSN facilities at each floor

	separately for boys and girls and upload the compliance with video link within 03 months on SARAS Portal.
6	School shall enroll all the staff for EPF facilities and shall make salary as per state Govt norms and shall upload the compliance with staff statement on SARAS portal within 03 months.
7	School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from CoE, CBSE, Bengaluru and shall upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
